Waste Management and Disposal Service

1. Overview

- 1.1 The Contractor shall provide a Waste Management and Disposal Service to deliver the following:
 - a) Provision of all bins/ receptacles for Waste collection and storage;
 - b) Storage of Waste in designated Site Central Waste Holding Facility; and
 - c) Final disposal of all Trust Waste off-site, using registered transport and ultimate disposal sites.
- 1.2 The Waste Management and Disposal Service shall be provided 24 hours per day, 365(6) days per year.
- 1.3 The Waste Management and Disposal Service shall be provided to support and meet all service requirements across the property portfolio in accordance with the Property Transformation Programme in Appendix 4 Part 4 of the Contract.
- 1.4 This Waste Management and Disposal Service applies to all properties identified as requiring the Service in the service matrix in Appendix E of the General Service Specification.
- 1.5 Not used.
- 1.6 For the avoidance of doubt, the timely movement of Waste from local storage areas and bins/ receptacles to Site Central Waste Holding Facility is included within the Cleaning Service Specification.
- 1.7 The Contractor is asked to consider, embrace and develop a truly integrated TFM service model with Site Staff responsible for delivering a number of Services e.g. cleaning staff also responsible for managing linen, Waste movement, catering duties etc.
