Thank you for your request concerning ADHD Assessments Adults & Children.

Your request has been considered and processed in accordance with the requirements of the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000.

For the last 10 years, or as many years as you have for that period, which you have data please provide a breakdown of:

1. **the number of Adult ADHD Assessments undertaken per year for upto the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.**
2. **the number of Adult ADHD Assessments for women undertaken per year for upto the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.**
3. **the number of Adult ADHD Assessments for men undertaken per year for upto the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.**
4. **the number of Children ADHD Assessments undertaken per year for upto the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.**
5. **the number of Children (Under 18) ADHD Assessments for girls undertaken per year for upto the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.**
6. **the number of Children (Under 18) ADHD Assessments for boys undertaken per year for upto the last 10 years. Ideally per calendar year.**

Please note: We can only provide data for the last 7 years. This is because we changed our Electronic Patient Recording system in 2013 and we are unable to reliably report on assessments before this date as differences in the systems would not give a true reflection.

This was further complicated when our Teams changed names in 2014/15. To validate the information requested would involve manually reviewing each record and to carry out this task would exceed the appropriate cost limit of £450; therefore we have provided you with the information from 2015 onwards in the attached spreadsheet.

Adult data has been provided using the Adult ADHD 28 Day KPI who have a F90.x Attention-deficit hyperactivity disorders Diagnosis. The CAMHS figures are from the CAMHS 28 Day ADHD KPI which counts service users with the ADHD activity.
