

Care Planning PRINCIPLES

The Plan MUST.....

- Be linked to the assessed need and risk assessment
- Drive personalised plans for service users
- Capture/reflect non self-directed interventions but promote self-determination (is this the right wording)
- Include social care needs
- Have contingency and crisis plans and include advanced decisions/directives
- Be CPA and Care Act compliant
- Document s117 needs
- Be straightforward and lowest possible impact administratively
- Make sense to the person
- Enable measurable outcome that is aligned to the future framework
- Be recovery focused
- Capture a person's preferences for treatment
- Be iterative and work for those service users that are new to treatment and those that have been in treatment for a while/long term
- On PARIS and accessible to all
- Holistic – must consider mental, physical, social and spiritual needs
- Wellbeing plan needs to be balanced between service users and carers perspective and service perspective
