Thank you for your request concerning Enoxaparin Medication.

Your request has been considered and processed in accordance with the requirements of the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000.

1. In 2023, of all the patients receiving enoxaparin, how many of them followed the posology of receiving injections once a day? And how many received injections twice a day?

The number of service users receiving enoxaparin injections may be incomplete or inaccurate due to our Electronic Prescribing and Medicines Administration (EPMA) system not being fully live in 2023. The information we have provided is from the wards that were functional with EPMA.

Under the FOIA the right of access is to the information which is held, not information which is accurate.

2023:

5 or less Service Users were given enoxaparin ONCE a day
5 or less Service Users were given enoxaparin TWICE a day.

Due to the small numbers of service users receiving enoxaparin injections we have applied Exemption Section 40(2). This is because entries of 5 or less are considered sufficiently small enough to be potentially identifiable data. On this basis, this information is exempt from the duty to publish.
